The colors of the stone are soft, neutral, and pleasing and have a cohesive flow when installed. Cottage Grove is a fieldledge thin veneer that can be used on large-scale projects without looking overly busy. This natural stone allows a great deal of design flexibility. Some stones are considered too modern for a mountain retreat or too rustic for a city home. Cottage Grove is neutral and versatile. It can easily be the focal point of modern, rustic, or traditional design.
